1. Canada Day Closures

As this year was Canada's 150th all sites that were open on Saturday July 1st were closed for the Holiday. The sites included; Perryvale, Athabasca, Whispering Hills, Boyle and Wandering River. The sites were posted with the closures 2 weeks prior the closures and no complaints, concerns or issues were reported.

2. Remembrance Day Saturday November 11th

This year Remembrance Day falls on a Saturday and will affect the following sites: Perryvale, Athabasca, Boyle and Wandering River. As this is during the start of the winter schedule of which Perryvale and Wandering River are only open on Saturdays starting November 1st the Commission will open the Perryvale and Wandering River Sites on the following Wednesday. Operators will notify users and all sites will be posted 2 weeks prior and notice will be added to the website.

3. National Recycling - Boyle

National Recycling has announced they have purchased the Miller Western Site in Boyle and will be proceeding with setting up a full metal recycling/processing facility and will be open to the public to purchase ferrous and non-ferrous metals. This recycling facility once in operation will have a significant effect on how the Commission handles its metals and will negatively impact Transfer Site revenues. Currently Transfer Sites accept metal and charge for it and then when each site reaches 80 to 100 ton of material a scrap metal contractor is called in and it is baled on site at no cost to the Commission. The fees charged for metal are part of the general revenue that sites receive. This is something that may affect the 2018 Transfer Site Revenue budget negatively by an estimated 5 to 7%. (15 to 20k) Some options for the Commission to consider will be to place bins at Transfer Sites for metal and haul it to National Recycling and get paid for it, but as metal prices fluctuate guaranteed revenue is not certain and may only cover just the trucking costs. The impact will likely be felt over a period of time so administration will monitor and report back to the Board at future meetings any options or scenarios that may be beneficial to the Commission.

4. Fall Appliance Round-Up

The annual Fall appliance round up was held September 8th to 17th. Approximately less than ½ of the total units (50) were received in the fall vs the Spring Round Up (114) Users do have an option to deliver their appliances at any time to the Regional Landfill free of charge and on average it receives 2 per month. Based on the advertising costs (1200) and revenue loss (1640) administration is considering cutting the advertising and setting firm dates annually on its website such as the spring roundup will be held the last 2 weeks of April and the Fall Round Up be held the last 2 weeks of August each year. Operators can inform users of the dates more easily and refer them to the website.

5. Rouge Web Information

Over the Summer we have had calls about our website having incorrect hours and days of operation listed and we have been investigating and contacting the sources. It happens when someone embeds your info within a newsletter or website and does not update it or remove it. To remedy the situation, we will be asking members when they are adding information to their site that they create a link to our website and not upload or embed any documents.
